As part of helping you and your child make the best subject choices, we formally invite you to our Subject Information Evening in **Harrison Hall**. The aim of the night is to help you understand how subject selection works and equip you to assist your child through this process. Your child will receive our 2019 Curriculum Handbook during the last week of Term 2 which will help you do this.

After each session, Learning Leaders and subject teachers will be assembled in designated areas in the Library for parents and students to approach for further information and to answer questions.
