### WHAT IS THE DOCTORS IN SECONDARY SCHOOLS PROGRAM?

Swan Hill College has been successful in being one of only 100 Victorian Secondary Schools to be part of the Doctors in Secondary Schools Program.

The College has also been successful in gaining the services of Dr Julia Coshin and Nurse Hollie Conlan (pictured).

All Secondary School students who are enrolled at the College will be able to access the GP at the school. Students and their parents/guardians/carers will not incur any out-of-pocket expenses for consultations with the GP. The GP will help with physical, mental, sexual and reproductive health.

Students will be able to access the GP themselves by contacting the Swan Hill Primary Health clinic directly on 5033 9900. (Mention you require an appointment with the Dr in Schools).
