Students also helped collect the diggers names, ages, years and dog tag details for the RSL register at the cemetery.

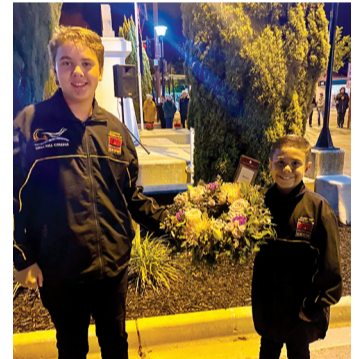
